


ENVIROFORESTERIE, THE SEARCH FOR EXCELLENCE AT THE SERVICE OF TIMBER MANAGEMENT

Located in the South of France, Enviroforesterie was created in 2012 with the objective of promoting the value of private forests by including them in a forest management process so that they benefit from the best maintenance and the most suitable forestry management.

Alongside the historical forestry development players (CRPF, Chambers of Agriculture, forestry syndicates, DDT, experts, cooperatives), Enviroforesterie supports all private forest owners by offering them forestry diagnoses, adapted forest management advice and a connection with regional forestry and harvesting professionals.

Enviroforesterie is particularly attentive to understanding owners' expectations and needs and to engaging them in sustainable forest management operations in accordance with current regulations and international forestry certifications.

Enviroforesterie's routine work is structured around 3 themes:

→ Sustainability:

Enviroforesterie supports the renewal of forests and their sustainable management, for example by favouring thinning cuts that contribute to tree growth.

→ Economic development:

When necessary, Enviroforesterie supports the forestry work and harvesting companies that will carry out the recommended management operations on the owners' plots. Support for administrative formalities and access to forestry certifications also make it possible to support the economic development of forestry and timber sector companies.

→ Responsibility:

Enviroforesterie makes owners aware of the essential role of their forestry management in the sustainability of the French forest resource.



OUR BUSINESS: HELPING OWNERS MANAGE THEIR FORESTS



DIAGNOSE:



Enviroforesterie's forestry technicians visit forest owners' plots to carry out a forestry diagnosis. In accordance with forestry regulations, the proposed forestry operations are defined according to the nature of their plot and their forestry objectives.



MANAGE:



As a Professional Forest Manager recognised by the Ministry in charge of the forest, Enviroforesterie supports owners in the drafting of sustainable management documents (Simple Management Plan, Code of Good Forestry Practices). These documents allow owners to plan the management of their forest over the long term, up to 20 years. They are approved by a state body (CRPF) in ac-

> Management Plan and national regulations.





CONNECT:

Voluntarily focused on forest management, Enviroforesterie does not buy or sell timber from the owners' forests. On a case-by-case basis, Enviroforesterie technicians put owners in touch with local PEFC-certified forest harvesting professionals who are referenced and selected by the Fibre Excellence Group and who are able to carry out the recommended forestry work.



CERTIFY:



Enviroforesterie supports owners in their voluntary efforts to obtain forest certification such as PE-FC, thus guaranteeing end-users that the timber comes from sustainably managed forests.

ENVIROFORESTERIE, A PLAYER AT THE SERVICE OF THE REGIONAL FORESTRY AND TIMBER SECTOR

Created by the Fibre Excellence Group, Enviroforesterie has a double objective:

1 To contribute to the development of the regional forestry and timber sector:

- Strengthen the forces promoting sustainable forest management.
- Increase the surface area of privately owned forests with management documents (PSG, CBPS...).
- **Support the development** of regional timber harvesting companies.

2 To allow the Fibre Excellence Group to deploy an integrated approach to the upstream and downstream use of timber resources.

• Enviroforesterie contributes to providing a local and sustainable supply to Fibre Excellence plants.

DID YOU KNOW?

Enviroforesterie is focused on innovation and the continuous improvement of its practices, it has a research and development department that works in a network with various research organisations, including the Forêt Cellulose Bois Ameublement (FCBA) technological institute.

The areas studied mainly concern forestry, forest harvesting and the use of forest biomass:

- Testing of new harvesting equipment or techniques taking into account the respect of ecosystems and the improvement of operator safety.
- Promotion and transfer of new technologies to the industry and forest owners (forestry itineraries, genetic improvement of forest species, climate change forecasting, etc.).
